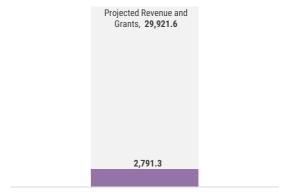

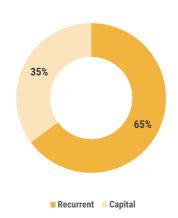

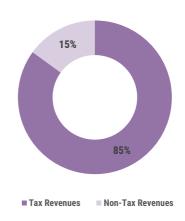


Cumulative Revenue and Grants

The cumulative revenue and grants for the period, 1 January to 20 February 2020, is MVR 2,791.3 million. Most significant receipts were received from tax revenues; TGST, GGST, Import Duty and BPT.

The cumulative expenditure for the period is MVR 2,740.8 million. The majority of expenditure during this period was spent on recurrent expenditure; Salaries and Wages, and Allowances to Employees. Notable spending on capital expenditure include Development Projects and Investment Outlays, and Land and Buildings.

The overall balance for the period is a surplus of MVR 50.5 million, as revenue received was higher than expenditure incurred during the period.

Net Issuance for the week, 16 to 20 February 2020, was a deficit of MVR 38.0 million. Government Securities worth MVR 1,436.9 million matured while MVR 1,398.9 million were issued.

Figures in this report may be different to reports published by other offices as the figures are recorded the day it becomes realised to the Public Bank Account.

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2019, but has been recorded as an expense in 2020. Cumulative 2020 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2019.
