Revisions to the RFP

1. GCC, Clause 1.9, Page 62 & 63

If the Procuring Entity determines that the Consultant and/or their Sub-Consultants has engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive coercive, or obstructive practices, in competing for or in executing the Contract, then the Client may, after giving 30 days notice to the Consultant, terminate the Consultant's employment under the Contract, and the provisions of Clause 2 shall apply as if such expulsion had been made under Sub-Clause 2.6.1(c).

Should any personnel of the Consultant be determined to have engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practice during the execution of the Contract, then that personnel shall be removed in accordance with Sub-Clause 4.3.

2. GCC, Clause 2.6.2 (a), Page 66

Amended as below.

If the Client fails to pay any money due to the Consultant pursuant to this Contract and not subject to dispute pursuant to Clause GC 8 hereof within forty-five (45) days after receiving written notice from the Consultant that such payment is overdue.

4. Special Conditions of Contract, Clause 2.3, Page 75

The time period shall be the duration taken to complete all the deliverables stated in the TOR or 15 calendar months, whichever occurs first.
