

MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS August 2020

Revenue and Grants for August 2020 stood at MVR 1,717.3 million, which is a 24.7% increase compared to the corresponding month of 2019. Although cumulative revenue was 39.1 percent lower than the same period in 2019, revenue figures for the review month highlight the recovery of revenue following the repercussions of the Covid-19 pandemic. Tax receipts, particularly from Business and Property Taxes, primarily contributed to the monthly year-on-year growth in Revenues and Grants.

Total Expenditure for August 2020 increased by 26.5% compared to the same month in 2019. Capital Expenditure for the review month had hiked by 125.9% from the August 2019. This was attributed to a MVR 319.88 million relative increase in Land and Building expenditures. Though Recurrent Expenditure relatively decreased by 0.8% from August 2019, this category registered the largest total expenditure for the August 2020.

Fiscal Balance for the month of August 2020 gives an overall deficit of MVR 712.1 million.

Note:

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2019, but has been recorded as an expense in 2020. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2020 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2019.
