- The Letter with reference number (IUL) 13-K/13/2019/43 refers to submission of an EOI (expression of interest). The ToR for the project however refers to "proposals" including "fees" as criterium for evaluation.
 - We would much appreciate to understand if we are to submit an EOI (excluding fees) or a proposal (including fees) on February 28.
 - EOI should be submitted excluding Fees.
- 2. If we are to submit an EOI we would much appreciate to understand if you have specific requirements regarding content, formal documents or different. Should we e.g. already include an approach & methodology for the services asked in the ToR?
 - As the REOI stipulates, the EOI should provide specific information which demonstrates
 that the party is fully qualified to perform the services (background of the firm's technical
 expertise, description of any similar assignments undertaken, experience in similar
 conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, value of those services, etc.). The
 additional details stipulated in the TOR will be required at the next stage (proposal
 submission stage).
- 3. We noticed section VI states, "The exercise should be completed within a maximum of six months." Could you please confirm if this duration of six months is intended for all four proposed stages of this master plan?
 - YES TOR section VI states that all four stages of the consultancy should be completed within a maximum of six months.
- 4. What documents are required with EOI? Would a standard letter suffice?

As the REOI stipulates, the EOI should provide specific information which demonstrates that the party is fully qualified to perform the services (background of the firm's technical expertise, description of any similar assignments undertaken, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, value of those services, etc.). The

additional details stipulated in the TOR will be required at the next stage (proposal submission stage).
