MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS June 2020



Revenue and Grants for June 2020 stood at MVR 394.8 million, which is a 78.2 percent decline compared to the corresponding month of 2019. This was primarily contributed by a MVR 1,106.7 million fall in Tax Revenue. Similarly, Non-Tax Revenue comparatively declined by MVR 297.8 million due to falls in Property Income receipts.

Total Expenditure for June 2020 decreased by 6.4% compared to the same month in 2019. Recurrent Expenditure for the month declined by MVR 117.5 million compared to 2019. Capital Expenditure had decreased by 3.6% primarily due to comparatively low expenditure on Infrastructure Assets.

Fiscal Balance for the month of June 2020 gives an overall deficit of MVR 1,781.1 million.

Note:

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2019, but has been recorded as an expense in 2020. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2020 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2019.
