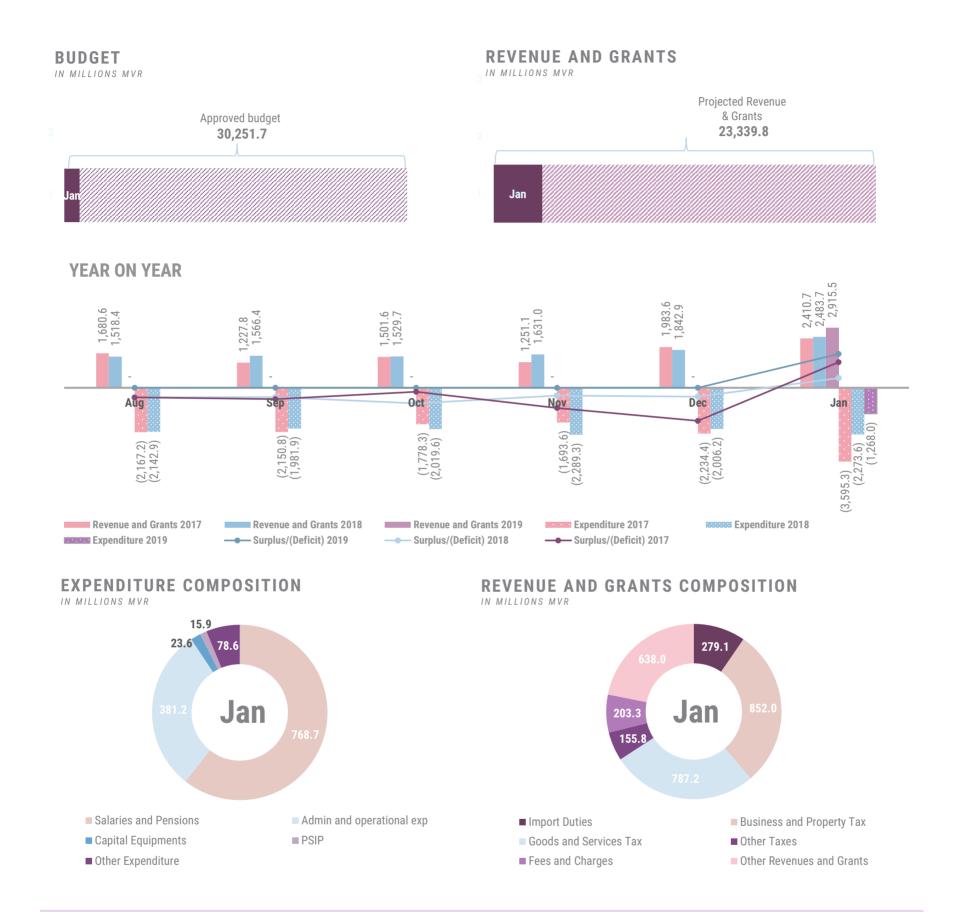
MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS January 2019



Revenues for January 2019 increased by 17.4% compared to the same period last year, mainly contributed by the increase in tax revenues. Significant on the year increases in revenues were seen in receipts from import duties and airport service charge.

Recurrent expenditure for January 2019 decreased by 1.0% compared to the same period last year. Recurrent expenditure was mainly incurred for personal emoluments and grants to students for education supplies. Spending on capital expenditures dropped by 86.1% with the fall in spending on PSIPs, capital equipments and lendings.

Fiscal balance for the month of January 2019 gives an overall surplus; contributed mainly by the significant increase in tax revenues and fall in capital expenditure.
