


## Installation of SAP GUI v7.40

Follow the below steps to install sap gui v7.40. Install sap using full administrative privilege administrator account / Local Administrator Account.


1. Open **"SAP GUI for Windows 740"** cd given by ministry of finance and treasury




2. Choose **SetupAll.exe**




3. Click on **Next**




4. Select options **"SAP GUI for Windows 7.40 (Compilation 1)"** and **"Business Explorer"**. Click **Next**.




5. Click **Next**.




6. Click **Next**.




7. Click **Close**.




8. Open **"Updates"** folder and Click **"SAP GUI 7.4 Patches"** folder.




9. Double-click on file “gui740\_10\_1-10013011.exe”. Click **Next**




10. Once installation is successful. Click **Close**




11. Open “**Updates**” folder and Click “**BI Addon for SAP GUI 7.40**” folder.




12. Double-click on file “**BI740SP07\_700-20012040.exe**”. Click **Next**



13. Once installation is successful. Click **Close**



14. Now run the script files ("**AssignFarumaAsDefault.vbs**" and "**UpdateServices.vbs**") using command prompt or double-click to each file.


