Revenue and Grants for March 2026 is 4,518.3 million, which is an increase of 8.8 percent compared to March 2025.

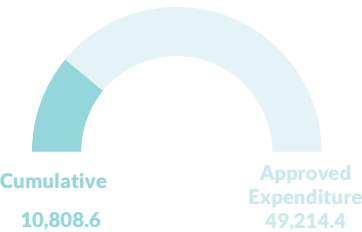
March 2026

Total Expenditure for March 2026 increased by 27.6 percent compared to the same period of 2025. Compared to March 2025, Capital Expenditure was 44.6 percent higher while Recurrent Expenditure increased by 25.0 percent.

IN MILLIONS MVR



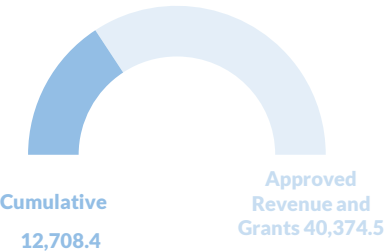
EXPENDITURE COMPOSITION - MARCH
