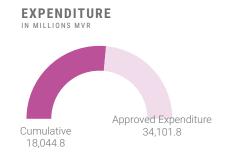
MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS

June 2022

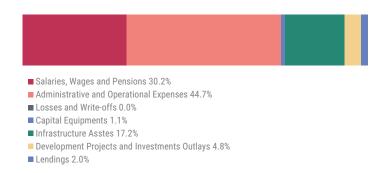
Revenue and Grants for June 2022 stood at MVR 2,850.7 million, which is a 85.9 percent increase compared to June 2021. A significant proportion of this relative increase is due to the marked increment in GST receipts.

Total Expenditure for June 2022 increased by 24.2 percent compared to the same month of 2021. Compared to June 2021, Capital Expenditure increased by 35.7 percent while Recurrent Expenditure increased by 20.8 percent. The relative hike in Recurrent Expenditure was due to rise in spending on Grants and Subsidies.

Fiscal Balance for the month of June 2022 gives an overall deficit of MVR 255.9 million.

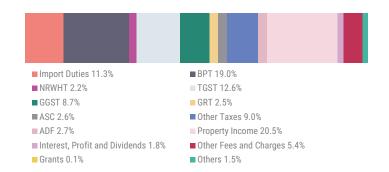


EXPENDITURE COMPOSITION - JUNE
