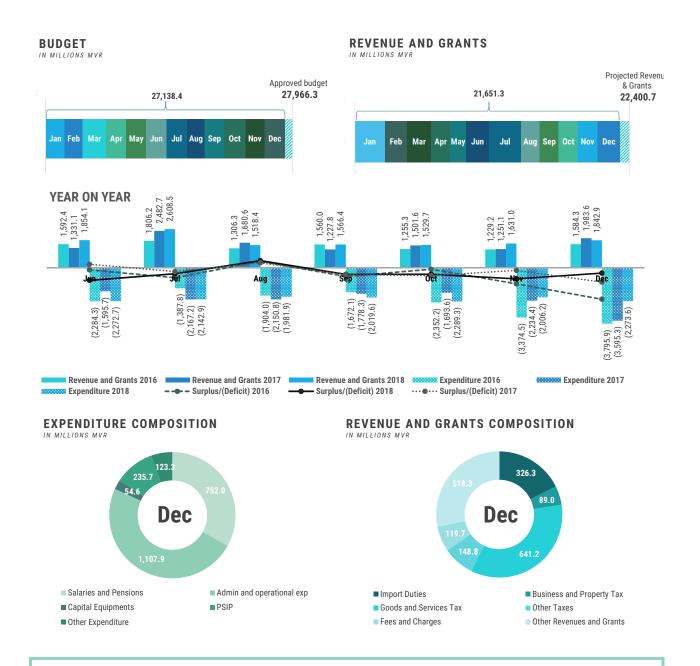
MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS **December 2018**



Revenues for December 2018 declined by 7.1% compared to the same period last year, mainly contributed by the decline in non-tax revenues by 28.3%.

Recurrent expenditure for December 2018 increased by 10.9% when compared to December 2017 mainly due to increase in Administrative and Operational expenses. Expenditure on Grants, Contributions and Subsidies, notably spending on subsidies more than doubled when compared to the same period last year. Spending on capital expenditures dropped by more than 78.7% with the fall in spending on PSIPs, capital equipments and lendings.

Fiscal balance for the month of December 2018 gives an overall deficit; contributed mainly by the significant increase in recurrent expenditure.
