1		In the bidding document FORM 2.5– Supply Requirement/ Technical Requirements, 1.1 Ice plant detail, the technical requirement is the seawater-cooled tube ice plant system, please specify that the ice making water is seawater or freshwater? If seawater is used to make tube ice, there will be two problems: one is that seawater will severely corrode the ice-making equipment, and the other is that the quality of the ice produced using seawater will not be very good. That will be better if the freshwater is allowed to use for ice making, and if so, who will responsible connecting the freshwater pipeline to the ice plant equipment?	The intake water should be seawater. Titanium tubes must be used in the compressor, and the materials used for other components or parts of the ice-making machine and water intake system should be suitable for producing ice from seawater.
2		Availability of crane or any other lifting machines to install the ice plants in each island.	Cranes and other lifting machinery are not available on most islands. If such equipment is required, the contractor must make the necessary arrangements. However, the Ministry will assist the awarded contractor in coordinating with the local council of each island to facilitate any necessary arrangements
3		Electric power supply available for each construction site in each island (single phase, three phase etc).	The contractor must make their own arrangements. All islands have local power stations and provide electricity services at commercial rates for such work sites. However, the Ministry of Fisheries and Ocean Resources will assist the awarded contractor in coordinating with the local council of each island to facilitate any necessary arrangements.
