MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS July 2020



Revenue and Grants for July 2020 stood at MVR 682.2 million, which is a 78.0 percent decline compared to the corresponding month of 2019. This was primarily contributed by a MVR 1,611.1 million fall in Tax Revenue due to repercussions of the Covid-19 pandemic. Similarly, Non-Tax Revenue comparatively declined by MVR 326.5 million due to falls in Property Income receipts.

Total Expenditure for July 2020 decreased by 7.1% compared to the same month in 2019. Capital expenditure for the review month had comparatively hiked from 2019 by 104.8%. This was attributed by a MVR 290.2 million relative increase in Investment Outlays. Recurrent expenditure in contrast had declined by MVR 519.2 million compared to the corresponding month of 2019.

Fiscal Balance for the month of July 2020 gives an overall deficit of MVR 1,387.8 million.

Note:

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2019, but has been recorded as an expense in 2020. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2020 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2019.
