Clarification 1

1. The delivery period is mentioned as 6 months. What is the duration for the installation?

Ans: Completion date: maximum 2 weeks after delivery to the site (Section 6- Schedule of Supply) - revised addendum shared in separate mail.

2. Will delivery period be considered for evaluation?

Ans: No the bidder is required to complete the delivery and related services within a period of 6 months + 2 weeks, the bids should comply with this time schedule. Para 3.3 of Section 3 categorically states "Deviation from Delivery and Completion Schedule" is not permitted.

3. Is there a particular preferred brand?

Ans: The particular brands are not required, yet the material should meet the specifications in the Bidding document.

4. Spare parts equipment's guarantee period?

Ans: 2 years

5. Can Bidders bid for one lot or more?

Ans: Bidders have option to bid for any particular Lot or any combination of Lots.

6. Is duty exempt for this assignment?

Ans: To be confirmed. We will be applying for duty exemption.

7. Clearance from Male' will be done by the Suppliers?

Ans: Clause 11.2 of the Section 8 (GCC), exclusively reads that "Scope of Supply shall include all such items not specifically mentioned in the Contract but that can be reasonably inferred from the Contract as being required for attaining Delivery and Completion of the Goods and Related Services as if such items were expressly mentioned in the Contract.

Further Clause 14.1 of GCC reads "Whenever the supply of Goods and Related Services requires that the Supplier obtain permits, approvals, and import and other licenses from local public authorities, the Purchaser shall, if so required by the Supplier, make its best effort to assist the Supplier in complying with such requirements in a timely and expeditious manner."

Therefore it is the Supplier's responsibility to clear the goods. The bidder may always cover such costs in Schedule 4.
