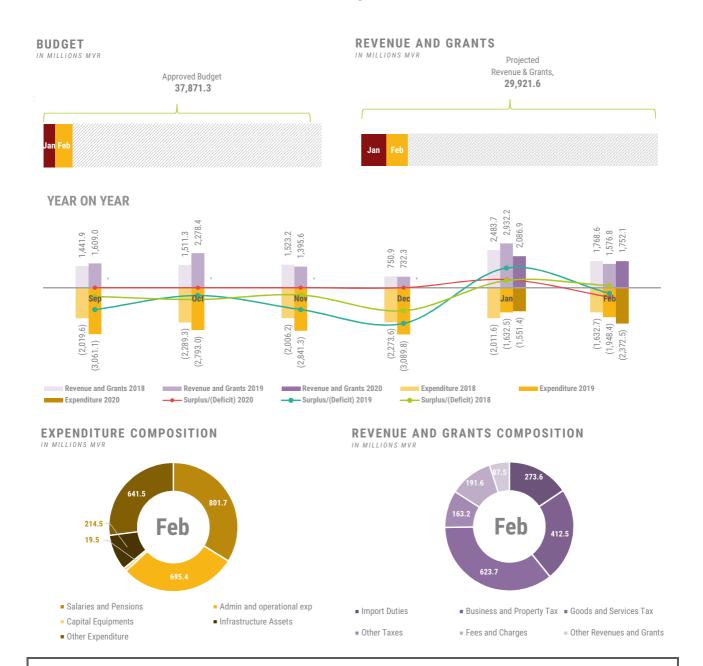
MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS February 2020



Revenue and Grants for February 2020 increased by 11.3 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2019, contributed by a MVR 134.55 million increment in Tax Revenues. Non-Tax Revenues increased by 18.5 percent compared to February 2019 primarily due to an increase in Fees and Charges.

Total Expenditure for February 2020 increased by 21.8 percent compared to February 2019 as a result of a 257.8 percent relative increase in capital expenditure. Relative spending on Recurrent Expenditure decreased by 12.1 percent mainly due to a drop in Losses and Write-offs.

Fiscal balance for the month of February 2020 gives an overall deficit of MVR 620.4 million.

Note:

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2019, but has been recorded as an expense in 2020. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2020 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2019.
