Economic and Financial Expert (National) shall preferably i) be Post Graduate in Economics or Finance, ii) have 5 years of experience in carrying out economic and financial analysis of large projects, and iii) sound knowledge of ADB procedures/ policies, with experience in similar projects. Experience in externally funded projects shall have added advantage.
