
MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS October 2020



REVENUE AND GRANTS COMPOSITION IN MILLIONS MVR 802.8 Oct 13.3 Admin and operational exp Capital Equipments Import Duties Business and Property Tax Goods and Services Tax

Revenue and Grants for October 2020 stood at MVR 835.0 million, which is a 42.8 percent decrease compared to the corresponding month of 2019. Decline in tax receipts from Goods and Services Tax and Interest, Profit & Dividends contributed to the relative decrease in Revenues and Grants for October 2020.

Total Expenditure for October 2020 decreased by 26.3 percent compared to the same month of 2019. Capital Expenditure for the review month saw a dip of 47.5 percent compared to October 2019. This was largely due to a MVR 236.5 million relative decrease in Development Projects and Investment Outlays. Similarly, Recurrent Expenditure declined by 15.4 percent compared to October 2019 following a significant decline in Administrative & Operational Expenses.

Infrastructure Assets

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2019, but has been recorded as an expense in 2020. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2020 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2019.
