Sl. No.	Queries Raised	Replies
1.	We observe that some of the quantities specified in the Bill of Quantities are not matching to the drawings. Can we use the bill forms Addition/ omission provided in Bill of Quantities for these items?	Bidders are advised to quote the prices against the items and quantities as specified in the Bill of Quantities. Bidders are further advised not to use the bill forms for addition/ omission for any items. In this regard, please refer to Section-7: General Conditions of Contract, Clause 14.1 (c), “any quantities which may be set out in the Bill of Quantities or other Schedule are estimated quantities and are not to be taken as the actual and correct quantities: (i) of the Works which the Contractor is required to execute, or (ii) for the purposes of Clause 12 [Measurement and Evaluation]”
2.	Is this a lump-sum Contract?	No. It is a unit price contract. Bidders are advised to quote the prices against the items and quantities as specified in the Bill of Quantities. Bidders are further advised not to use the bill forms for addition/ omission for any items. In this regard, please refer to Section-7: General Conditions of Contract, Clause 14.1 (c), “any quantities which may be set out in the Bill of Quantities or other Schedule are estimated quantities and are not to be taken as the actual and correct quantities: (i) of the Works which the Contractor is required to execute, or (ii) for the purposes of Clause 12 [Measurement and Evaluation]”
3.	Should the Details of Machineries be included?	Please refer to Section-4: Bidding Forms, Form EQU: Equipment.
4.	The dumping areas for the dredged material provided are not adequate and some of the dumping grounds are probably in residential areas which may disturb the nearby residents while dumping the dredged material. Kindly advise.	The dumping ground locations are provided by the Kulhudhuffushi Island Council. The Employer shall convey the feedback of the bidders to the council and will request them to earmark some new areas for dumping of the dredged material. The new dumping areas, if required, shall be conveyed to the successful bidder. However, the dredged material shall be dumped and stacked as per requirement mentioned in technical specifications.
5.	We request to kindly share the presentation made during pre-bid.	Yes, shall be shared. However, it is only for reference.

6.	Is there any official site visit planned?	No. There is no official site visit proposed. However, the interested bidders may conduct a site visit on their own under intimation to the Employer.
7.	In some tender drawings, we need more measurements to calculate the quantities, such as drawing for revetment. It is requested to share the AutoCAD drawings.	The AutoCAD drawings cannot be shared. However, the revetment drawing showing more measurements are shared. Bidder's are once again advised to not use the addition/ omission bill forms and quote the prices against the quantities specified in the Bill of Quantities.

The Employer informed the bidders the following additional points:

1. In accordance with ITB 4.5, following documents are acceptable by the Employer for the Government Owned Enterprises in the Employer's country which are required to be submitted along with the Letter of Bid:
 - a. Memorandum of Association
 - b. Articles of Association
 - c. Complete Audited Financial Reports
2. The Employer requested the bidders to also submit the Excel sheets of the priced BoQ in the soft copy submission for ease in Evaluation of Bids by the Employer. However, the prices quoted in the excel sheets shall not be considered during evaluation and in case of any discrepancy among the original signed and stamped hard copy submission and the excel sheets, the prices quoted in the hard copy shall prevail.
3. The financial statements of the bidders must be audited and duly certified. The bidders must submit the audited, signed and stamped financial statements by a certified auditor. The financial statements not signed and stamped by a certified auditor shall not be considered.
4. The reports of EIA, Geotechnical Investigations and Bathymetry chart are provided on the request of bidders for reference only. It is the responsibility of the bidder to verify the same.
5. Bidders are requested to refer to the EIA report for the type of equipment allowed for undertaking the dredging and reclamation works.
