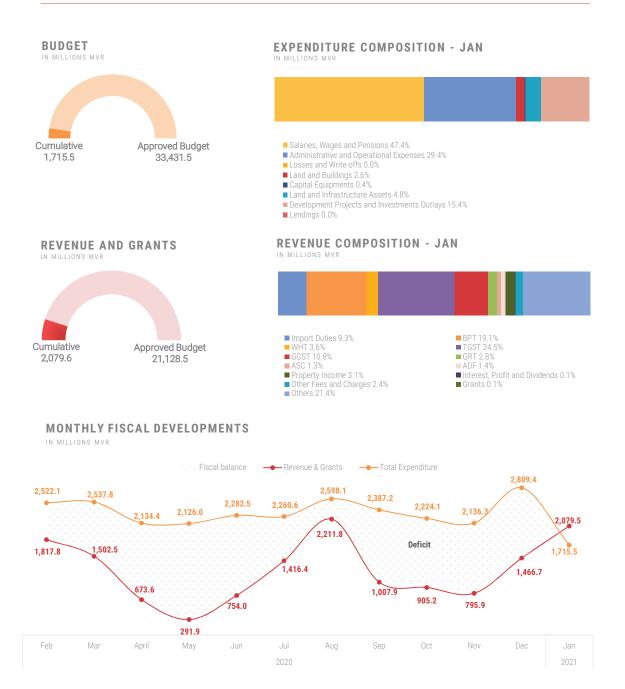

MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS

Revenue and Grants for January 2021 stood at MVR 2,079.6 million, which is a 7.9 percent decrease compared to January 2020. A significant proportion of this relative decline is due to a 33.9 percent drop in Non-Tax Revenues.

Total Expenditure for January 2021 increased by 5.1 percent compared to the same month of 2020. Recurrent Expenditure dropped by 4.6 percent whereas Capital Expenditure hiked by 58.2 percent compared to January 2020.

Fiscal Balance for the month of January 2021 gives an overall surplus of MVR 364.1 million.



Note:

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2019, but has been recorded as an expense in 2020. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2020 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2019.
