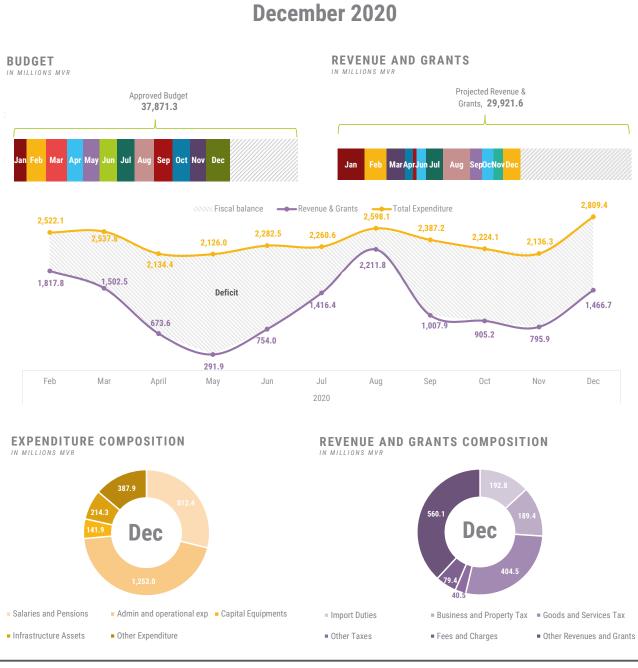
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MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS

Revenue and Grants for December 2020 stood at MVR 1,466.7 million, which is a 32.3 percent decrease compared to the corresponding month of 2019. Decline in tax receipts and non-tax receipts contributed to the relative decrease in Revenues and Grants for December 2020.

Total Expenditure for December 2020 decreased by 31.1 percent compared to the same month of 2019. Recurrent Expenditure decreased by MVR 845.4 million in December compared to the corresponding month of 2019. This was primarily due to relatively lower Administrative & Operational Expenses and significantly lower Losses & Write-Offs.

Fiscal Balance for the month of December 2020 gives an overall deficit of MVR 1,342.7 million.

Note:

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2019, but has been recorded as an expense in 2020. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2020 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2019.
