



MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS

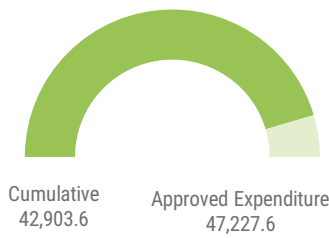
November 2023

Revenue and Grants for November 2023 is 2,238.6 million, which is a 15.3 percent increase compared to November 2022.

Total Expenditure for November 2023 increased by 47.9 percent compared to the same month of 2022. Compared to November 2022, Capital Expenditure increased by 133.7 percent while Recurrent Expenditure increased by 24.5 percent.

Fiscal Balance for the month of November 2023 is an overall deficit of MVR 1,674.6 million.

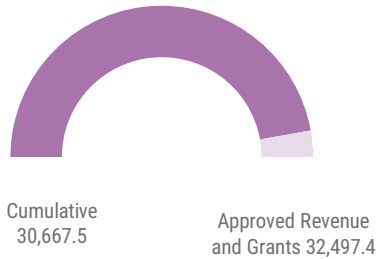
EXPENDITURE IN MILLIONS MVR



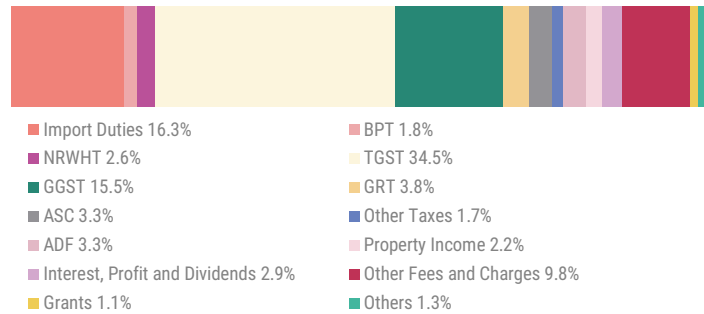
EXPENDITURE COMPOSITION - NOVEMBER
