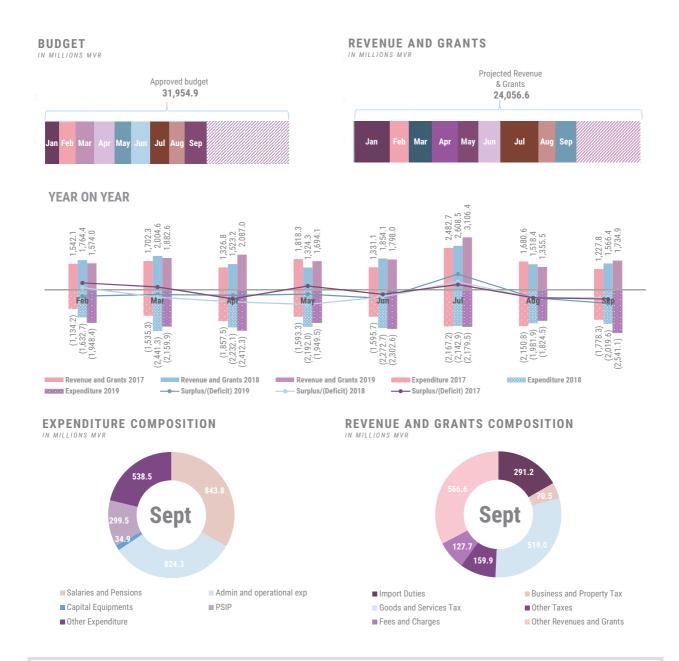
## MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS September 2019



Revenue and Grants for September 2019 increased by 10.8% compared to the same month last year, contributed by an increase in tax revenue, non-tax revenue and grants received. The increase in tax revenue was contributed by Business and Property Taxes, Import Duties, Goods and Services taxes, Green tax and Airport Service charge received during the month. The increase in non-tax revenue was mainly with the receipt of SOE dividends.

Total expenditure increased by 25.5% compared to September 2018 resulting from increase in recurrent expenditure. It increased by 38.9% compared to the same period last year, mainly driven by a rise in spending on personal emoluments, grants, contributions and subsidies and travelling expenses. Spending on capital expenditure dropped by 13.5% due to the decline in spending on PSIPs and investment outlays.

Fiscal balance for the month of September 2019 gives an overall deficit of MVR 806.2 million.

## Note:

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2018, but has been recorded as an expense in 2019. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2019 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2018.
