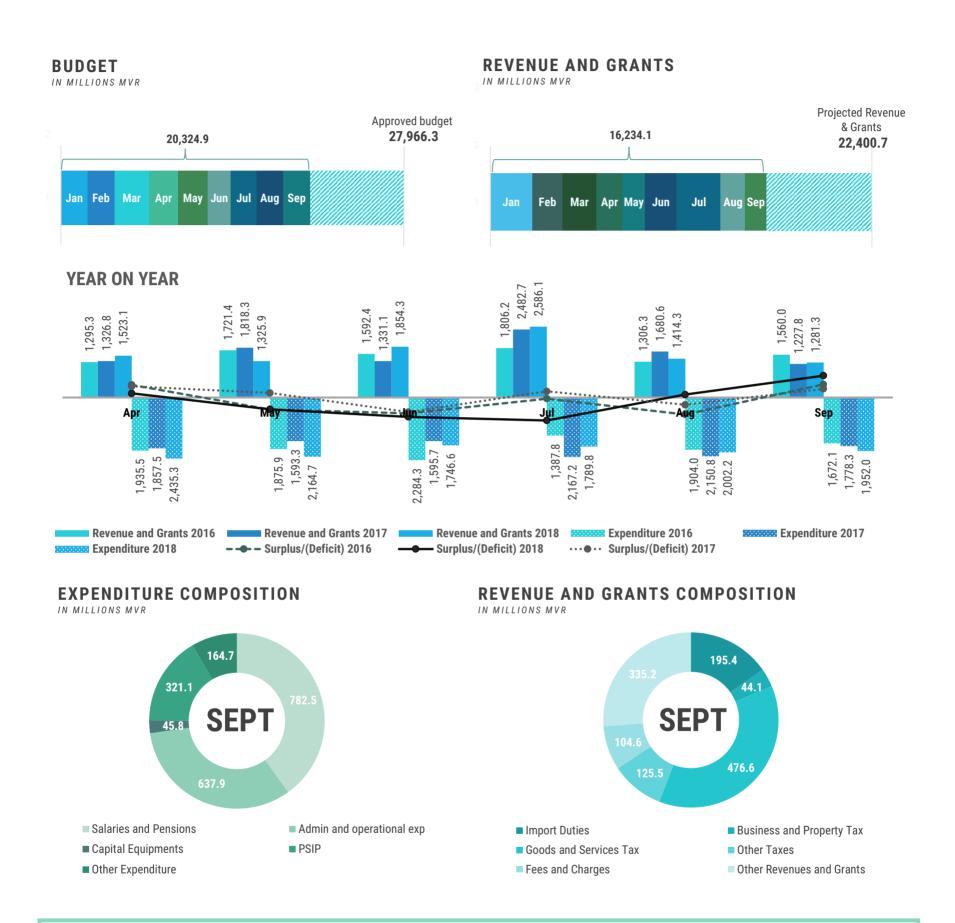
MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS September 2018



Revenues for September 2018 has increased by 4.4% compared to the same period last year, mainly contributed by non tax revenues by over 20.2%. This is mainly due to the timely rent payments received from resorts as per agreement made and increase in collections from airport development fee.

Recurrent expenditure for September 2018 increased by 9.8% when compared to September 2017 mainly due to increase recurrent expenditures by 14.2%. Training related expenditures and spendings on subsidies have increased compared to the same period last year. Spending on capital expenditures have dropped by 1.0% with the fall in PSIPs.

Fiscal balance for the month of September 2018 gives an overall deficit; contributed mainly by the increase in recurrent expenditure.
