## CLARIFICATION 03

#	Section/Clause	Query	Response
1		<p>We have been reviewing the proposed payments terms and payment conditions included in the draft contract proposal. Some of them are not fulfilling our minimum standards. Due to this reason we are going to include in our bid our proposal for payment terms and payment conditions. We are open to negotiate it during the evaluation process.</p> <p>We just want to note and have a confirmation from your side that we will not be awarded without previously have negotiated and have made an agreement with that points during the evaluation process.</p> <p>The main question is related to the bid security that we are presenting which have the risk to be executed if after being awarded we reject the project.</p> <p>We understand that in case that we do not make an agreement on the payment terms and conditions during evaluation process then we will not be awarded anyway. Consequently, the bid security will not be executed due to we would be disqualified and not awarded.</p> <p>Is that correct?</p>	<p>The payment terms and conditions will not be negotiated during the evaluation process but only after evaluation with the 1<sup>st</sup> ranked responsive bidder.</p> <p>Case 1: the bid is considered as not responsive, then the bid security will not be executed and will be sent back to the bidder.</p> <p>Case 2: the bidder is considered as preferred one and he will enter into contract negotiations. In case the negotiations fail for some reasons and the bidder could not be officially awarded than the bid security might be executed to cover the losses due to another re-tendering or due to the negotiation with another responsive bidder which has a higher price.</p>
