



# MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS

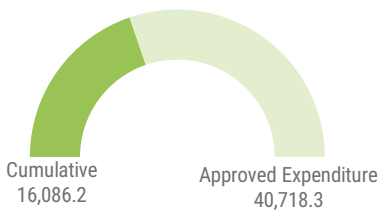
## April 2023

Revenue and Grants for April 2023 is 2,463.01 million, which is a 13.8 percent increase compared to April 2022.

Total Expenditure for April 2023 increased by 38.0 percent compared to the same month of 2022. Compared to April 2022, Capital Expenditure increased by 63.8 percent while Recurrent Expenditure increased by 30.2 percent.

Fiscal Balance for the month of April 2023 is an overall deficit of 1,286.6 million.

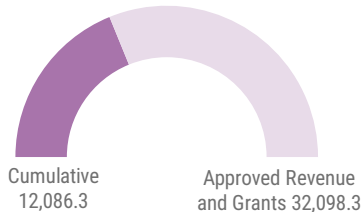
### EXPENDITURE IN MILLIONS MVR
