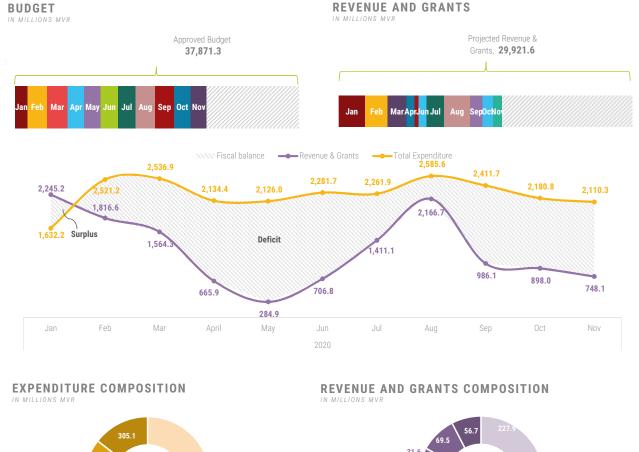
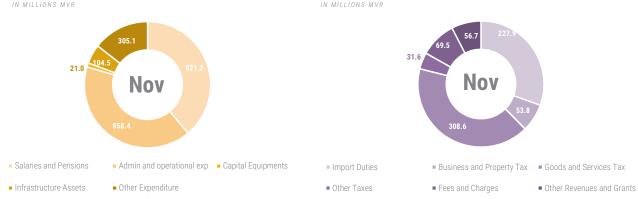
MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS November 2020





Revenue and Grants for November 2020 stood at MVR 748.1 million, which is a 50.2 percent decrease compared to the corresponding month of 2019. Decline in tax receipts from Goods and Services Tax contributed to the relative decrease in Revenues and Grants for November 2020.

Total Expenditure for November 2020 decreased by 25.7 percent compared to the same month of 2019. Capital Expenditure for the review month saw a dip of 58.0 percent compared to November 2019. This was largely due to an MVR 469.5 million relative decrease in Infrastructure Assets. Similarly, Recurrent Expenditure declined by 7.6 percent compared to November 2019 following a significant decline in Administrative & Operational Expenses.

Fiscal Balance for the month of November 2020 gives an overall deficit of MVR 1,362.2 million.

Note:

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2019, but has been recorded as an expense in 2020. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2020 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2019.
