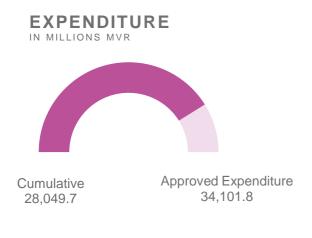
MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS

September 2022

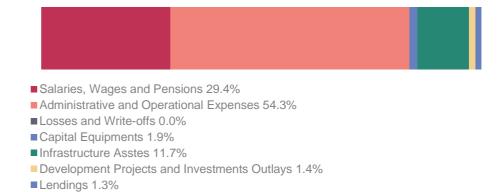
Revenue and Grants for September 2022 stood at MVR 1,579.4 million, which is a 32.2 percent decrease compared to September 2021.

Total Expenditure for September 2022 increased by 6.6 percent compared to the same month of 2021. Compared to September 2021, Capital Expenditure decreased by 47.4 percent while Recurrent Expenditure increased by 33.3 percent.

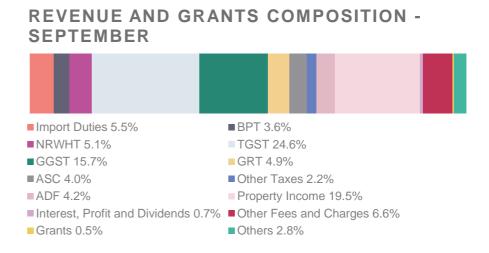
Fiscal Balance for the month of September 2022 gives an overall deficit of MVR 1,571.4 million.
