INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Ministry of Finance, on behalf of Ministry of Health (the Employer), wishes to annul the bidding process on invitation for Bids Ref (IUL)13-K/13/2018/267 and re-invites bids from local and international eligible and qualified bidders for the **Construction of N.Velidhoo Health Center Extension 2 Storey Building, under Contractor Finance**
2. **International Competitive Bidding (ICB)** will be conducted in accordance with the Public Finance Regulation of Maldives. Qualifications requirements are stated in the Bidding Document.
3. Only a listed member of the National Contractors Registry will be eligible to participate in this tender. International bidders shall seek all applicable Foreign Investment Registration and Foreign Direct Investment Policy requirements of Maldives prior to bid submission.

The Employer shall not be liable for any information not received by the Bidder. It is the Bidder's responsibility to verify the website for the latest information related to this Bid.
6. The Bidder shall furnish a bid security of **MVR 1,300,000.00 (One Million Three Hundred Thousand - MVR or equivalent in USD)** for the project. The Bid security shall be valid for 148 days from the date of bid opening.
7. Any clarifications to the project may be sent to the address in clause 8 of this invitation for bids on or before **1330 Hours Maldivian Time on Thursday, 10th December 2020.**

8. Bids shall be valid for a period of 120 days from the date of bid opening and shall be delivered to the Ministry of Finance at the address specified in Clause 9 of this Invitation for Bids, on or before **1100 hrs Maldivian Time on 17th December 2020**, at which time they will be opened in the presence of the Bidders who wish to attend the bid opening.
