

MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS

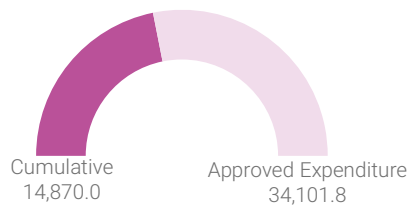
May 2022

Revenue and Grants for May 2022 stood at MVR 1,650.5 million, which is a 47.0 percent increase compared to May 2021. A significant proportion of this relative increase is due to the marked increment in GST receipts.

Total Expenditure for May 2022 increased by 13.7 percent compared to the same month of 2021. Compared to May 2021, Capital Expenditure declined by 14.7 percent while Recurrent Expenditure increased by 23.7 percent. The relative hike in Recurrent Expenditure was due to rise in spending on Grants and Subsidies.

Fiscal Balance for the month of May 2022 gives an overall deficit of MVR 1,129.6 million.

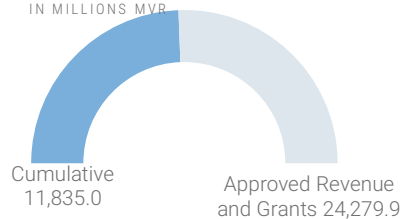
EXPENDITURE IN MILLIONS MVR
