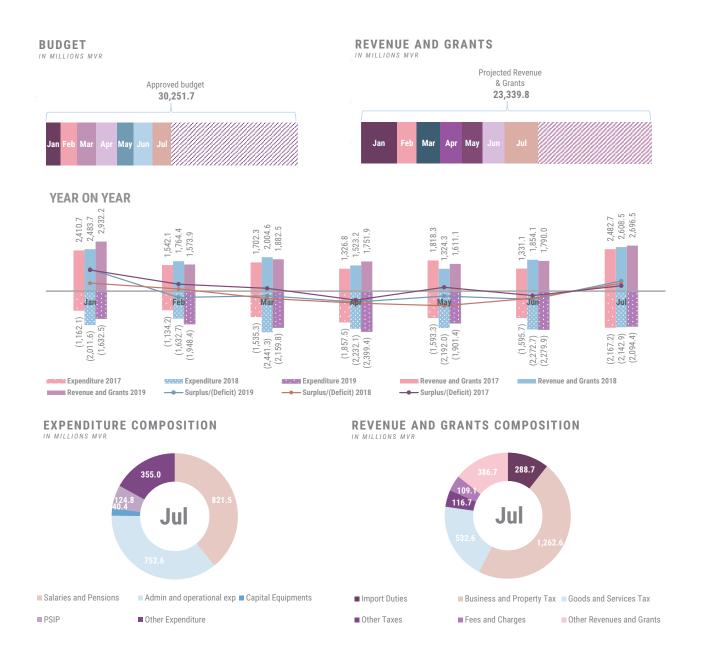
MONTHLY FISCAL DEVELOPMENTS July 2019



Revenue and Grants for July 2019 increased by 3.4% compared to the same period last year, contributed by a rise in tax revenues. Tax revenue increased due to improved performance of tourism sector revenues, GRT, ASC, TGST in addition to GGST and BPT. Non tax revenues declined mainly as a result of decrement in interests and profits and tourism land rent.

Total expenditure declined by 2.3% compared to July 2018 resulting from a decrease in capital expenditure. Recurrent expenditure increased by 17.4% compared to the same period last year, mainly driven by a rise in spending on personal emoluments, Aasandha and losses and write-offs. Spending on capital expenditure dropped by 52.2% due to a significant decline in spending on PSIPs.

Fiscal balance for the month of July 2019 gives an overall deficit of MVR 178.0 million.

Note:

Total expenditure include figures where budget was consumed in 2018, but has been recorded as an expense in 2019. Negative figures represent reversal entries posted to the Public Accounting System during the review period for which purchase orders were raised in previous periods. Cumulative 2019 expenditure is likely to be understated as expenditure for this period includes reversal entries for transactions for which budget has been consumed in 2018.
